Facts About Diabetes

- + Nearly 30 million children and adults in the United States have diabetes.
- + Another 86 million Americans have pre-diabetes and are at risk for type 2 diabetes.
- + People with diabetes are nearly 2 times more likely to be hospitalized for a heart attack or stroke.
- + Diabetes causes nearly 50% of all cases of kidney failure.
- + The estimated total national cost of diagnosed diabetes in the United States is \$245 billion.
- + Recent estimates project that as many as one in three Americans will have diabetes in 2050 unless we take steps to Stop Diabetes.
