Food provided by the caterer of your choice will be served by volunteer members unless other arrangements are made by the family or caterer.

OSELC will no longer cook or bake for funeral luncheons.

Prior to contacting catering services you will want to determine:

- Date and time of event
- Event location
- Serving time (before or after graveside service)
- Number of expected guests
- Plan for leftover food.

Caterers should contact luncheon coordinators as arrangements are being made in order to determine type of food, arrival time and number of servers needed to make guests welcome.
